

CAN I RECEIVE COVID VACCINE - 19

IF I HAVE ALLERGIES?

NO

- The anaphylactic reaction to the vaccine or vaccine ingredients is a contraindication to vaccination

YES

- If you have had an allergic reaction within 4 hours and / or anaphylaxis associated with a vaccine or an injectable drug that does not contain a component or a cross-reactive component of COVID-19 vaccines, you may be given COVID-19 vaccine.
- You will be asked to wait in the clinic for 30 minutes after the vaccine.

YES

- If you have a history of significant allergic reactions and / or anaphylaxis to any food, medicine, venom, latex or other allergens unrelated to COVID-19 vaccines, you may be given COVID-19 vaccine.
- You will be asked to wait in the clinic for 30 minutes after the vaccine.

YES

- If you have problems with allergies, such as runny nose, sneezing, itchy nose and eyes, asthma and eczema, you can get the vaccine.
- You will be asked to wait in the clinic for 30 minutes after the vaccine.
