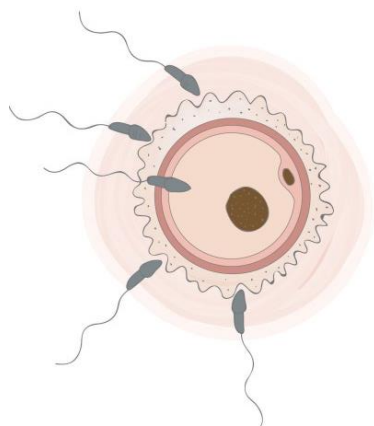


PREGNANCY, FERTILITY AND VACCINES



Do vaccines cause INFERTILITY?

The WHO would NEVER approve vaccines that are suspected of affecting a person's ability to conceive.

WHY SHOULD I GET VACCINATED IF I AM PREGNANT?

- Pregnancy entails a greater vulnerability of women to certain infections.
- Vaccines are safe and effective.
- Vaccines prevent diseases and complications in both the woman and the baby.
- Vaccines work for both the woman and the baby.
- While babies are in the womb, they share some benefits with their mother, such as antibodies. If you get vaccinated you will transfer those antibodies to your baby.



! *Adverse effects*

Mild and transient such as fever or inflammation. Being pregnant does not mean you are more likely to have an adverse reaction.
