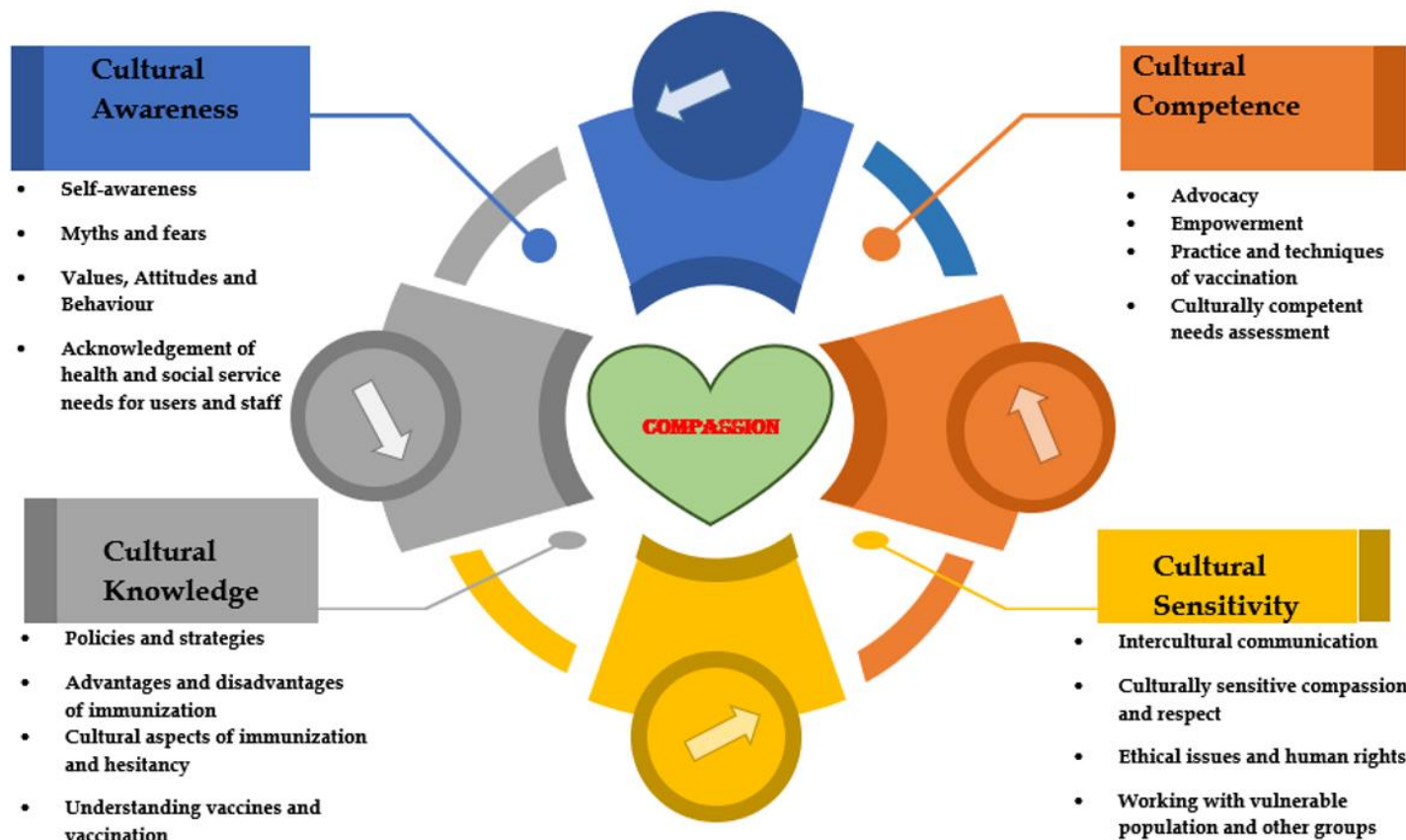

DELPHI STUDY

The 2nd result of the Project is to strengthen the aspects related to vaccination and immunization in the training curricula and education of healthcare professionals, by creating an innovative Training Curriculum focused on promoting vaccination and tackling the vaccine hesitance. The Curriculum addresses primarily nurses and doctors involved in delivering vaccination, school nurses and doctors, community nurses, health visitors but also to sanitary mediators and other healthcare professionals working with disadvantaged people and vulnerable groups or other hard to reach groups. It is aiming at enhancing their knowledge, communication skills, cultural and social competences and empower them for promoting vaccination and tackling the vaccine hesitancy. The IENE11 Training Model is based on the PTT/IENE Model developed during the IENE projects. The curriculum is composed of four learning Modules following the four constructs of the PTT/IENE Model and the conceptual PTT/IENE11. Each module comprises four sub-constructs which represent the content map. The statements were developed based on the international and partners' national literature reviews, and established through a Delphi study on four thematic areas: a) Policies, Strategies and legislation related to vaccination and immunization programmes b) Information on vaccine and vaccination, c) Behavior and attitudes towards vaccination, d) Interventions to promote vaccination and tackling of vaccine hesitancy.



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RESULT 3

BITE SIZED LEARNING TOOLS

MOOC

The training curriculum will guide the creation of 16 Bite-Sized Learning Units for nurses and healthcare professional. The Training Curriculum and the set of the Bite-sized Learning tools will be available on the website which can be used by healthcare workers for self-learning in four PDF document in English, Romanian, Spanish and Greek, which can be downloaded and used for offline learning.

Also, the learning tools and modules produced based on the PTT/TRN model will be used for the development of the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) to be delivered by the IENE 11 Project over a period of six-weeks.
