The MOOC will be delivered from **October 2nd to November 10th, 2023**.

The course "Promoting vaccination and tackle vaccine hesitancy" aims to enhance knowledge, communication, cultural and social skills of nurses, medical doctors, community health workers and healthcare professionals, empowering them fighting disinformation, tackling the vaccine hesitancy and improving vaccine confidence to people that are more hesitant or people from disadvantaged groups.

The course is addressing the healthcare and social care workers involved in delivering vaccination, nurses or doctors, school or community nurses, teachers and students of the healthcare and socialcare fields or other healthcare professionals wishing to improve their knowledge and skills on vaccination.

## The Course Content

Each Module contains 4 Units, one day is dedicated for each unit. Every day, the learners are invited to do Learning activities, communicate with other participants on the Forum dedicated for the unit and do a short self-Assessment quiz.

To drive the self learning, a Bite sized learning tool was created for each unit, with basic **information** on the topic and a variety of media and links to **Internet**.

In the last week Synthesis, the participants will develop a post-course plan of action "Applying learning to practice" and complete the impact evaluation survey.


## **Assessment and Certificate**

The participants will be graded for the quizzes automatically and the facilitators will assess and grade the plan of action and the activity on the dedicate forums.

The participants you get 75% from the total of 100 points will receive a participation acknowledgement and Certificate.

The MOOC will run on the Mindclass platform for six weeks and consists 40 hours of training:

The course includes four Modules: Module1 - Cultural Awareness, Module 2 - Cultural Knowledge, Module 3 - Cultural Sensitivity and Module 4 - Cultural Competence.
